Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity. — 1 Timothy 4:12, NLT

These values are just a small part of who we are as a church. We have based them on Scripture and challenge every leader to aim for them.

A Keypoint Leader Must:

1. Believe in Jesus Christ as Savior and express Him daily as Lord.
2. Be water baptized.

A Keypoint Leader Commits To:

Listen more than you speak. (James 1:19)

Engage in constant personal growth and development. (2 Peter 3:18)

Actively reach out to those beyond your group. (Matthew 28:19)

Develop a balanced life in faith, family, and finances. (Matthew 6:33)

Encourage members to have a role in the group. (Ephesians 4:16)

Return a tithe (10%) of your income to the local church. (Malachi 3:10)

Surrender all that you have to Jesus Christ, and commit to the pastoral leadership of KPC. (Galatians 2:20; Hebrews 13:17)

Humbly and authentically lead your group, using Scripture as your guide. (Matthew 20:26)

Invest your time in potential and emerging leaders. (2 Timothy 2:2)

Pray constantly for your group members and pastoral staff. (1 Timothy 2:1-2)

A Keypoint Leader Refrains From:

Dominant leadership (Luke 22:26; Mark 10:45; 1 Thess. 5:14)

Excessive alcohol consumption or public drunkenness (Rom. 14:21; Eph. 5:18; Prov. 20:1)

Profanity and abusive language (Eph. 4:29; Col. 3:8; Matt. 15:10–11)

Sexual immorality (1 Cor. 6:18; 1 Thess. 4:3–5; Heb. 13:4)

Any violation of your personal conscience (Heb. 10:22; 1 John 2:27; James 4:17)

Any behavior that may cause Christ to grieve and/or others to stumble (Rom. 12–13)
